As a social responsibility to the unemployed & unskilled youth as well as to fill in the gap between demand & supply of skilled manpower in the Tourism related sectors, the Govt. of India has passionately designed and sponsored these courses.

1).Hospitality Training Programme: To create employable skills in the following areas :

- Food Production – 8 Weeks
- Bakery & Patisserie – 8 weeks (Baker)
- Food & Beverage Service – 6 weeks
- Housekeeping Utility – 6 weeks (Housemen / Housekeeper)
  
- 8<sup>th</sup> Pass in the age group of 18 to 28 are eligible
- Stipend of Rs. 2,000/- for 8 weeks programmes & Rs. 1,500/- for 6 weeks programmes will be paid on attaining 90% of attendance.
- No Course fee is levied
- Classes will be conducted during evening.
- Opportunities will be provided in getting jobs in Hotel Industry, candidates should join job after successful completion of the course.

\*\* Courses under Hospitality Training Programme are also being conducted and employment shown for *differently abled candidates* viz. hearing impaired and orthopedically effected to a certain degree of impairment.

## **2). Skill Testing & Certification:**

Unrecognized, but skilled workers in the industry need to be certified for bridging this gap which would result in their better mobility and recognition:

Initially, competencies for two trades of **Cooks and Waiters** would be identified under the following categories:

**COOKS:** i) Assistant Cook ii) Cook (Fast Food) iii) Cook (Indian Cuisine or Regional Cuisine) iv) Cook (International Cuisine) v) Cook (Chinese) vi) Baker and viii) Halwai.

**WAITERS:** i) Assistant Waiter ii) Waiter iii) Barmen iv) Bartender v) Steward vi) Butler vii) Pantryman and viii) Pantry Attendant

The program would involve a 1 to 3 day workshop to sensitize the personnel on the testing standards that would be expected. In case of gaps, training would be provided to such personnel.

- Working in the Hotel Industry are only eligible for the Programme.
- I H M will pay each candidate Rs. 300/- per day during orientation period to offset wage loss.
- I H M will maintain a register of persons trained / tested / certified which will be recorded in the National Registry maintained by Ministry of Tourism.

## **3). Upgradation of Communications Skills of IHM students:**

To improve communication skills of those IHM students who had lesser opportunity/exposure in the past.

## **4). Certified Hospitality Trainer Programme:**

To develop the skills in teaching and prepare faculty for hotel management training.

- Final Year (62% in I & II Yr. aggregate) or passed out (60%) students of 3-Year B.Sc. in Hospi. & Hotel Admn. Of IGNOU / NCHMCT are eligible

- AICTE approved college, Degree should be 4 Years with 60% marks are eligible
- Stipend of Rs. 10,000/- per month would be paid on attaining 90% of attendance
- On successful completion, eligible to get faculty positions in IHMs
